Madi Sakande was born in Burkina Faso 44 years ago, he lives today in Calderara di Reno (Bologna, Italy). In





EPI Activities

Seven different European Cities have assessed their current integration policies and activities, answering the Intecultural City Index questions. The result was the publication of the Intercultural City Review report, where their performances are measured and ranked.

The next step is to design strategies to improve the processes and pilot them with the support of several private and public stakeholders, but also citizens. The process will also be supported by the EPI technical partners and external experts.

One of the EPI cities, Cluj-Napoca (Romania) was selected to participate at the thematic workshops *How to design one-stop-shops as an integrated response to integration needs* within the CONNECTION project. A 'One-Stop-Shop' is a type of service delivery model based around a welcoming space where migrants can access multiple specialist services to support integration, all under one roof. Being actively involving in the process of 'One-Stop-Shop' design and establishment during these thematic workshops, Cluj-Napoca municipality will have access to best practices exchanges on common issues and challenges; meetings with key stakeholders to hear their experience and ideas on the theme, such as migrant community organisations, other NGOs and city services; visits to see how projects are being implemented on the ground in the host city.
